

Weiss Praised for Parachute Skimmer

Fort Lauderdale, Fla., Masters swimmer Scot Weiss recently received accolades for his new invention, the Parachute Skimmer. The patent-pending device is a revolutionary new pool skimmer, and can skim the surface of a pool in a fraction of the time it takes with a traditional pool skimmer. The device is pulled through the pool and captures floating debris as it glides along the top of the water. Its design allows users to maneuver the device as it skims the pool surface.

Weiss calls the device "the push broom for the pool." It was used in the search for the re-

mains of a missing 3-year-old child in Orlando, and received national attention when Nancy Grace discussed it on CNN. At the Orlando Pool and Spa Show in February, the Parachute Skimmer was recognized as the top new pool cleaning product. <<<
